Quick Track Tuition Credit Application

School Year 2013-2014

Application Deadline: May 1, 2013

The Quick Track Tuition Credit program provides a credit for each eligible child attending The Hebrew Academy. As illustrated in the charts below, the Quick Track credit is based on the family's Adjusted Gross Income and number of children at Hebrew Academy. This application is due by May 1, 2013. Please note that late applications will not be accepted.

Eligibility Requirements:

- 2011 Adjusted Gross Income must be below \$250,000.
- Family's assets (excluding equity on primary residence and retirement accounts) must be less than \$300,000.
- To maintain the grant, families must submit a new application and continue to meet eligibility requirements each year.
- Families that receive this grant are not eligible to receive Traditional Financial Aid or Discover Hebrew Academy grants.
- This grant will be revoked if a tax return is not provided on or before August 15, or if the tax return shows that the family does not meet eligibility criteria.

It is not necessary to submit both a Quick Track and a Traditional Financial Aid application.

If you believe you will require more assistance than is provided under the Quick Track program, please complete the Traditional Financial Aid application which can be downloaded at www.thehebrewacademy.org. If you submit the Traditional Financial Aid application, we will determine your eligibility under both programs and will award a grant that is most advantageous to you within the guidelines. Please note that the deadline for all applications is May 1, 2013 and that late applications will not be accepted.
